What is the Keep Safe Card?



The Keep Safe Card is run by the Northamptonshire Keep Safe Partnership. You can find out who the partners are on the website www.keepsafenorthants.org



It is for anyone in Northamptonshire who may have a disability or illness which makes them feel vulnerable when out and about.



What does the Keep Safe Card do?



It makes people aware of their personal safety.



It encourages people to report crime.



It encourages people to look for help if they need it.



Using your Keep Safe Card



Please keep your Keep Safe Card with you when you go out.

You can show it to someone if you need help.



If you see this logo in a window it means the staff working there know about the Keep Safe Scheme and can help you.



But if you can't find somewhere with a sticker in the window you can show your card to others who may be able to help you.

They can call for help for you using the information on the card.



The police, fire and ambulance service know about the Keep Safe Card.

They will know what support you need even if you don't have your card with you.
