## EXECUTIVE ORDER 0002 – ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INTERIM MANAGEMENT TEAM FOR THE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSION

By the authority of the Police and Crime Commissioner as designated by the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, and, by democratic mandate invested in me by the electorate of Northamptonshire, I have taken the following decision:

To establish an interim management team for the Police and Crime Commissioner

The role of the Police and Crime Commissioner is significantly different and wider than the previous Police Authority. It therefore requires different support arrangements. The Commissioner has established an interim management team to provide this support to enable the Commissioner to deliver improvements in policing and justice.

Assistant Commissioner for Justice – Iain Britton. Iain will lead work to improve and speed up justice in the county and the Commission's work to put victims of crime first.

Assistant Commissioner for Governance – Kathryn Buckle. Kathryn will lead work on management of decision making, processes and democratic accountability.

Assistant Commissioner for Resources – John Raisin. John will lead the determination of the police budget, the need for secure substantial savings and the drive to improve value for money.

Assistant Commissioner for Engagement – Peter Heaton. Peter will lead the Commission's public engagement work.
