## EXECUTIVE ORDER 0005 – CONTRACT AWARD FOR ROBERT STREET OFFICE REFURBISHMENT TO BOOTHVILLE ROOFING CONSTRUCTION

By the authority of the Police and Crime Commissioner as designated by the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, and, by democratic mandate invested in me by the electorate of Northamptonshire, I have taken the following decision:

To award a contract for the refurbishment of the Robert Street office in Northampton to Churchill Contract Services Ltd. The contract is valued at £345,146.88

The Robert Street office of Northamptonshire Police requires essential refurbishment to make it fit for purpose to provide accommodation for officers and staff. By refurbishing Robert Street, additional capacity for officers and staff will be created, allowing further moves across the existing Northamptonshire Police estate to occur. This will provide a more efficient and effective service for the county.

The refurbishment has been included within the Estates strategy of the Force and funding has been identified previously within the capital budget.

The Commissioner has agreed with the recommendation of the facilities teams within the Force to award the contract to Boothville Roofing Construction.
