EXECUTIVE ORDER 0007 – FUNDING DECISIONS ON REGIONAL COLLABORATION PROJECTS: IT, HR, INFORMATION ASSURANCE AND VETTING

By the authority of the Police and Crime Commissioner as designated by the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, and, by democratic mandate invested in me by the electorate of Northamptonshire, I have taken the following decision:

To agree to spend committed funding on four regional collaboration projects with the four other forces and Commissioners in the East Midlands region.


A £1.1 million Regional Collaboration Fund has previously been set up for investing in projects across the East Midlands Forces (Northamptonshire, Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire). Northamptonshire's committed to this fund is for 14% of the costs.

The Commissioner has agreed with the recommendation of the Force to utilise this funding for (figures relate to total spend across the five forces):

- IT: £335,000 to support immediate costs of resource and hardware in support of regional delivery of IT to support operational collaborations
- Information Assurance: £88,000 to provide dedicated resources for information assurance requirements to collaborative units whilst reviewing options for the most effective future structure
- HR: £19,000 to support scoping work for options related to the Police Staff Council
- Regional Vetting: £19,500 to develop existing computer systems databases to be used across the region and to enable electronic document management.
