Please also include communications role at the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.
- 3) Please could you breakdown the following for your force **and** the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner
- a) what job roles are currently in the Corporate Communications Department/(vacant and occupied
- b)at what Grade and salary per annum (in £) they are
- c)and how many posts there are of each role
- 4) Please could you clarify annual spend for the corporate communications department overheads from 2012-2016.
- 5) Could you provide a breakdown of the total number of posts in Corporate communications (including communication roles within OPCC) for each year between 2012-2016.
- 6) Could you provide a breakdown of the total number of media-related posts in your force and in the OPCC for each year between 2012-2016.
- 7) Could you provide a current corporate communications departmental structure chart."

Answer

I am writing to advise you that, following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you requested is not held by the Office of the Northamptonshire Police and Crime Commissioner.

The Office of the Northamptonshire Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) and Northamptonshire Police are two separate legal entities. Information regarding operational policing matters is the responsibility of Northamptonshire Police, therefore the OPCC does not hold any of the information you have requested. Northamptonshire Police's Information Unit may hold some of the information you are seeking.
